Our teaching and support staff work towards a common goal – to ensure every student maximises their potential to enable them to access their chosen career pathway.

Qualifications focus around the STEM subjects (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths), while students at GCSE level also study core subjects including English Language and Literature, and a choice of three additional subjects. Those joining the Sixth Form have a choice of A-levels, Vocational courses or a combination of both, or can choose to study a T-Level Engineering pathway.
