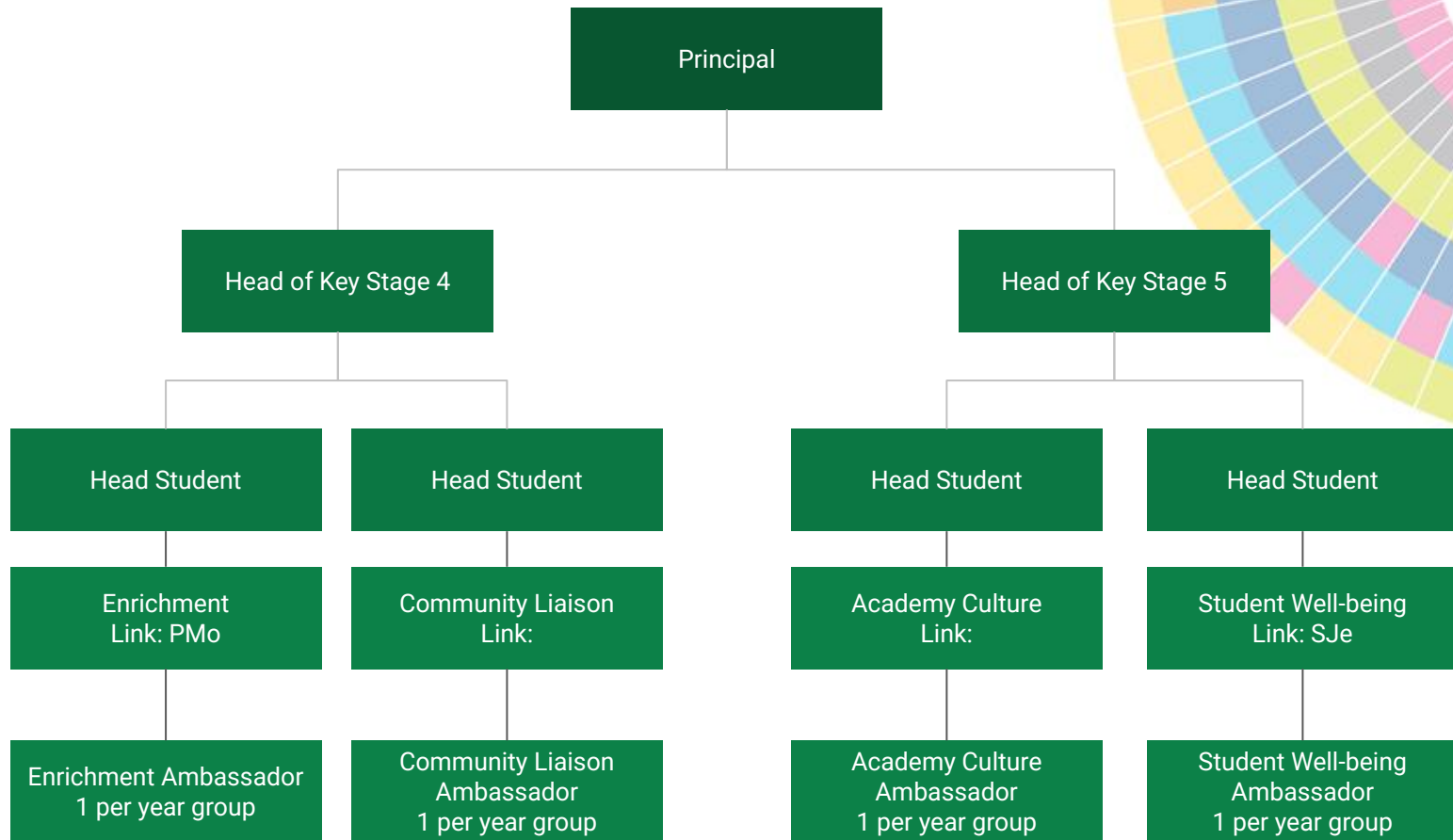

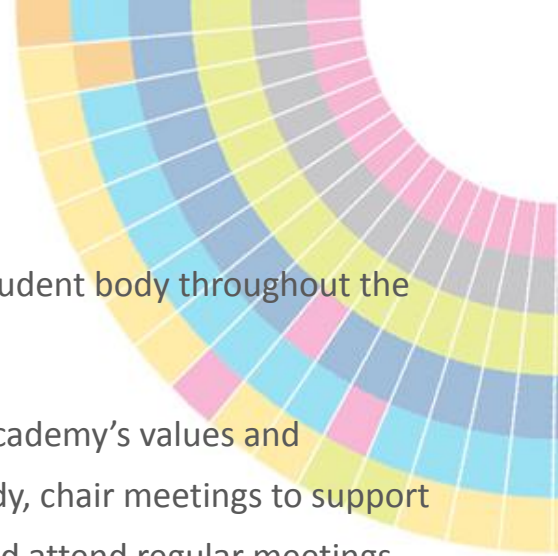

# Enrichment Ambassador

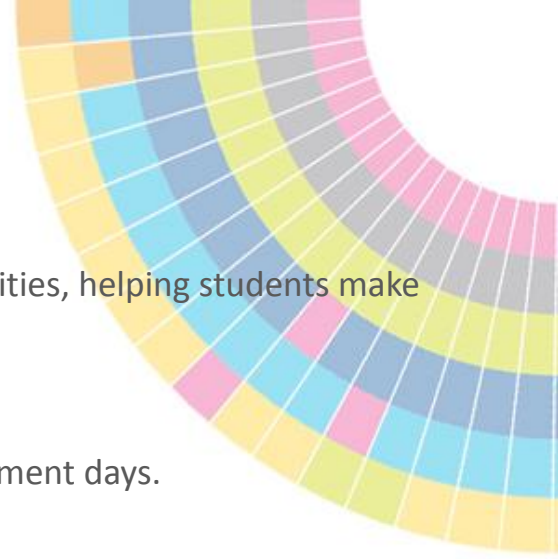
To promote and support extracurricular activities, clubs, and enrichment opportunities, helping students make the most of their time at Academy beyond the classroom.

# Student Well-being Ambassador

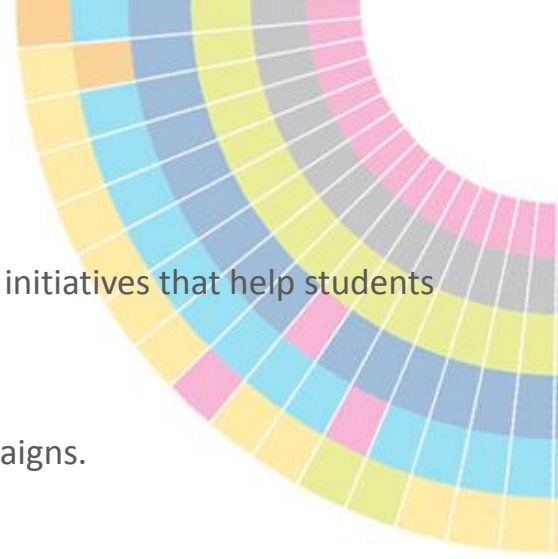
To promote positive mental health and wellbeing across the Academy and support initiatives that help students manage stress, build resilience, and seek help when needed.
